

TROOP UNIFORM

All Scouts are expected to wear the full "Class A" uniform to all troop activities. Unless otherwise announced.

Following is the official Troop 746 Boy Scout "Class A" Uniform:

1. Boy Scout hat
2. Green Neckerchief with Red Trim
3. Boy Scout shirt
4. Olive cargo pants or Scout uniform pants
7. Scout web belt and Boy Scout belt buckle
8. Merit badge sash (not required for troop meetings)

INSIGNIA – REQUIRED

The following insignia (i.e., patches) are required on the Troop Uniform. Check front and back covers of the official Boy Scout Handbook for placement of patches.

1. American Flag – right sleeve, top
2. Rank Badge – left front pocket**
3. Arrow of Light – on left front pocket, above lower seam
4. 746 Numerals – left sleeve, immediately below council strip
5. Leadership position – left sleeve**
6. World Crest – centered above left pocket, half way between pocket and shoulder seam.

** Troop furnishes the initial item. Scouts are charged for replacements. Duplicate rank badges, merit badges, leadership patches, etc., may be purchased from the Advancement Chairman.

INSIGNIA - MISCELLANEOUS

1. Order of the Arrow Lodge Flap – right pocket flap
2. Camporee or other special event patches - may be hung from right pocket button
3. Merit badges – Sewn or ironed on the merit badge sash
4. Religious award – to the wearer's right above the left pocket
